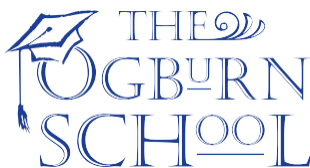

## Graduation Requirements

**To earn a high school diploma from The Ogburn School, Inc., students must complete the following courses:**

- 4 English credits (English 1, English 2, English 3, English 4)
- 4 Math credits (Algebra 1, Geometry, required, Choose two from: Math for College Readiness, Algebra II, Special Topics in Math, Trigonometry, Probability and Statistics)
- 4 Science credits (Earth Science, Biology, Environmental Science required, + one elective science)
- 3 Social Studies credits (World History, American History, American Government, Economics w/Financial Literacy)
- 9 Electives (Required electives include: Life Management, Outdoor Education, Personal Financial Literacy, and Career Research and Decision Making)

**\*\*Students must complete at minimum of 25% of the courses required to graduate from The Ogburn School.**

***Honors Courses Available: Prerequisites apply***

A 2.0 GPA is required to earn a high school diploma from The Ogburn School.

*Students must submit scores from the MAP Online for each academic year of enrollment before a student is promoted or transcript issued.*

*Juniors and/or seniors may submit SAT/ACT, or MAP Online scores to meet test requirements.*
